It is triumphant as the story of a man who transcended unspeakable adversity, became a Professor of Languages, founded an important college, oversee the translation of Scripture into 36 Indian and Asian dialects, established scores of schools in Northern India, and blazed the way for generations of missionaries from all denominations.
