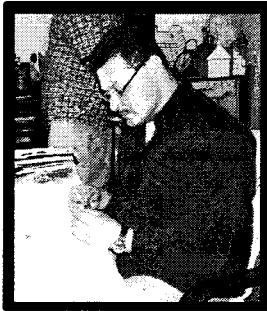




LOVE LINK LETTER

March 2007



Acquaintances told Gary about Love Link Ministries, Inc. He first came in July of 2005. He stayed for 5 months, left, came back again in January of 2006 for two weeks, then left again. He participated in the First

Step Program and then he returned to the Love Link Recovery Program in December of 2006. He has been back in the program for 3 months.

“Spiritual needs are being met. Just stopping doesn’t bring happiness. You’d be sober, but still unhappy. God brings me faith. Without Christ in my life I’d be drinking and locked up somewhere. I can’t stay sober without God in my life. He’s the only hope for me.”

“The most difficult part of the program is realizing I have to accept things I cannot change. Learning from past mistakes has been difficult. I had to choose recovery and make a decision to work on my addiction to alcohol.”

“It is my duty as a Christian to tell others about what God has done for me.” Sometimes it is hard because I still have cravings. I spend a lot more time on my relationship with God than I ever have before.”

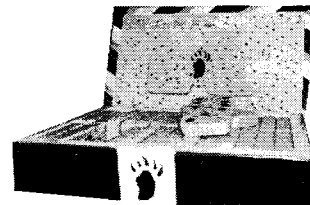
“I hope to gain happiness in my new life of sobriety through Jesus Christ. Gratitude to God is my greatest hope. Without Him I wouldn’t be where I am right now. He’s blessed every one of us by being with us. I take Jesus Christ very seriously. People have turned their backs on me but Jesus picks me up, dusts me off, and always stays by me. I love Him so much.”

“Some programs don’t include God – just a higher power. They encourage us not to share just about God. Our weekly activities keep us busy. For Love Link Ministries we journal

daily and turn it in once a week. We attend all 3 services on Sunday and help with the meals. We also attend Celebrate Recovery on Monday evenings at Western Oaks church of the Nazarene. On Wednesday evening we have a Bible Study at 1st Indian Church. On Thursday we attend the evening church service. On Friday we attend Recovering for Christ. Sometimes, on Saturdays we have free time. On Tuesdays and Fridays some of the men help with the food pantry.”

Gary recommends the program to others. But to succeed, they must be serious about dealing with their addiction. He works in Craft Link. He enjoys cutting and sanding the Corian and creating art with it. Below is a beautiful domino set Gary handcrafted. 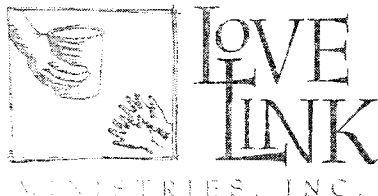
