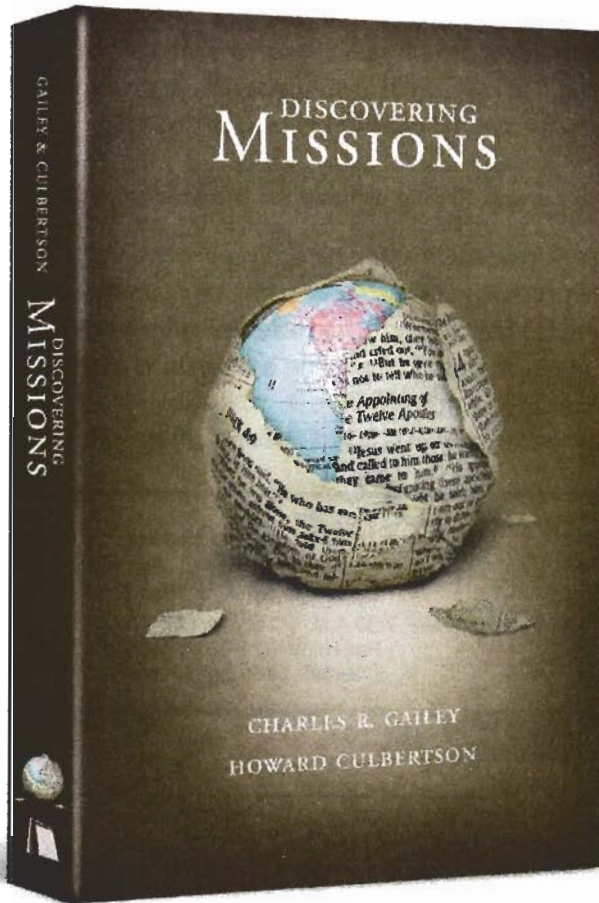


DISCOVERING MISSIONS

CHARLES R. GAILEY is emeritus professor of missiology at Nazarene Theological Seminary where he has educated hundreds of new missionaries. A former missionary to Swaziland, he has served as vice president of the Evangelical Missiological Society, president of the Midwest Professors of Mission, and a member of the board of directors of the American Society of Missiology. He received a Ph.D. from the University of South Africa.

HOWARD CULBERTSON teaches missions at Southern Nazarene University and helps head the university's short-term mission trip opportunities program. A veteran missionary, he spent 15 years overseas (10 years in Italy and 5 years in Haiti). While at SNU, he has been heavily involved in church-planting programs in Bulgaria, Croatia, and Slovenia as well as helping with the ministry to Haitian immigrants in Venezuela. He holds an earned doctorate in missions from Denver Seminary.
